I know that for those of you whose kids are going to Kindergarten next year, this might be a bit of an emotional time for you. You want to make sure your child is ready for kindergarten, but yet you want to embrace this short time you have in this stage of their life. I am here to tell you, relax. Enjoy this time with your child. They are only this age once, and you won't get it back. As much as we push these children to know all these academic skills before Kindergarten, we also want them to enjoy time with you and have time to be a kid. Get outside. Enjoy the weather as it's warming up and spend time as a family.

Now, I'm not saying throw the learning out the window. Please don't do that. BUT find fun ways to help your child learn. I will tell you right now, a child who doesn't know their letters does not want to sit down and do flash cards. Find a way to learn with the a topic your child enjoys. If your child loves to play with match box cars, put some stickers on them with letters and ask them to drive around the car with the letter "A." You can also have them sort the cars by color, size, etc. If your child loves playing with dolls, have them count how many dresses that doll has and compare if she has more shoes or shirts. You can find fun learning opportunities everywhere with your child. The most important thing you can do with your child is to be present. Take the screens away and go on an adventure, even if it's just to the park or ice cream shop. I had a parent tell me that one time they woke up all of their kids after they went to bed, jumped in the car, and drove to the ice cream shop. Make memories that will last a lifetime with your kids, that is what matters, not the latest and greatest gaming system or the expensive shoes. You will never get this time back, so make the most of it.
